BUSINESS RATES AND PLANNING

1. Business Rates

Getting started with Business Rates. If you have recently taken on a business premises in Colchester it is important that you register for business rates as soon as possible. You may be eligible for business rates relief which would mean that you have a reduced bill or don't have to pay anything.

Being registered will help the Council to keep accurate records of local businesses, ensure you are billed correctly and will avoid any unexpected costs later down the line. It will also ensure that you are able to access any government support as quickly as possible.

2. Rateable Value

The Valuation Office Agency (VOA) is responsible to give each business premises a rateable value. If you feel that your rateable value is incorrect you are able to complete a check, challenge or appeal directly with the VOA.

If you propose to provide licensable activities at a premises, including the sale and supply of alcohol, provisions of regulated entertainment and provision of late-night refreshments you may be required to hold a premises license.
